POTATOES



At Planting: 2 quarts of Earthquake (or Earthquake Plus), 2 to 5 gallons Phos Factor Z, 1 quart of Micro-N-Rich per acre. Consider adding 1 quart of Liquid Kelp to this application. If using a starter other than Phos Factor Z, add the Earthquake, Micro-N-Rich and possibly, the Liquid Kelp to the at planting application.

When applying 32-0-0 or 10-34-0, add 2 quarts of Earthquake (or Earthquake Plus) and 4 ounces of Nano N+

Cal-zone Liquid Calcium can be added to applications of 32-0-0 at an applictaion rate of 3 to 5 gallons per acre.

In-season foliar applications based on crop need:

- Phos Factor Z (7-24-0 w/Zn) can be foliar applied at 1 gallon per acre with 1 quart of Earthquake.
- Triple 8 Plus (8-8-8 w/ 6 micros) can be foliar applied at 2 quarts per acre with 1 quart of Earthquake.
- Payback (2-16-16 w/ 6 micros) can be foliar applied at 2 quarts per acre with 1 quart of Earthquake.
- DropKick21 (4-0-21 with Boron) can be foliar applied at 2 quarts per acre with 1 quart of Earthquake.
- BrimStone 17 (8-0-0-17S) can be foliar applied at 2 quarts per acre with 1 quart of Earthquake.

Products to consider adding to foliar applications based on crop need:

- BOLT bio-stimulant can be added to any application at 1 pint per acre (up to 1 quart per acre)
- 4 ounces of Nano Phos or Nano K
- Liquid Kelp (1 quart per acre)

COMMENTS:

- When applying Sugar Creek Ag products with other products, including herbicides, pesticides & fungicides; a jar test is recommended for compatibility.
- When applying foliar nutrients, herbicides and fungicides, add 4 ounces of Nano Pro to every application
