

# SOD / TURF



**Spring Green Up:** Apply 2 to 4 quarts of Triple 8 Plus with 2 quarts of Earthquake Plus, per acre.

Can be applied with most herbicides (use WILDFIRE when applying herbicides).

**During the growing season (every 2 to 4 weeks):** Apply 2 to 4 quarts of Triple 8 Plus per acre with 1 quart of Earthquake Plus. Can be applied with most herbicides (use WILDFIRE when applying herbicides).

Applications made spring or summer may include the following products, when the crop need dictates:

- Payback for a lower N and higher P & K value; 2-16-16 with 5 micronutrients (2 quarts per acre)
- Micro-N-Rich 3-0-0 with 5 micronutrients (1 to 2 quarts per acre)
- BrimStone 17 for added Sulfur (1 to 2 quarts per acre)

**Late Fall:** Apply 2 quarts of Earthquake Plus with 2 quarts of Payback, per acre.

**Seeding or plugging:** Apply 2 quarts of Earthquake Plus with 2 quarts of PaybackK, per acre.

## COMMENTS:

- When applying Sugar Creek Ag products with other products, including herbicides, pesticides & fungicides; a jar test is recommended for compatibility.
- One quart of Liquid Kelp can be added to any application during the growing season.
- 4 ounces of Nano Pro per acre is suggested when making foliar applications, especially when herbicides and fungicides are being applied.
- If your crops are needing calcium, consider applying Cal-zone. 100% plant available!
